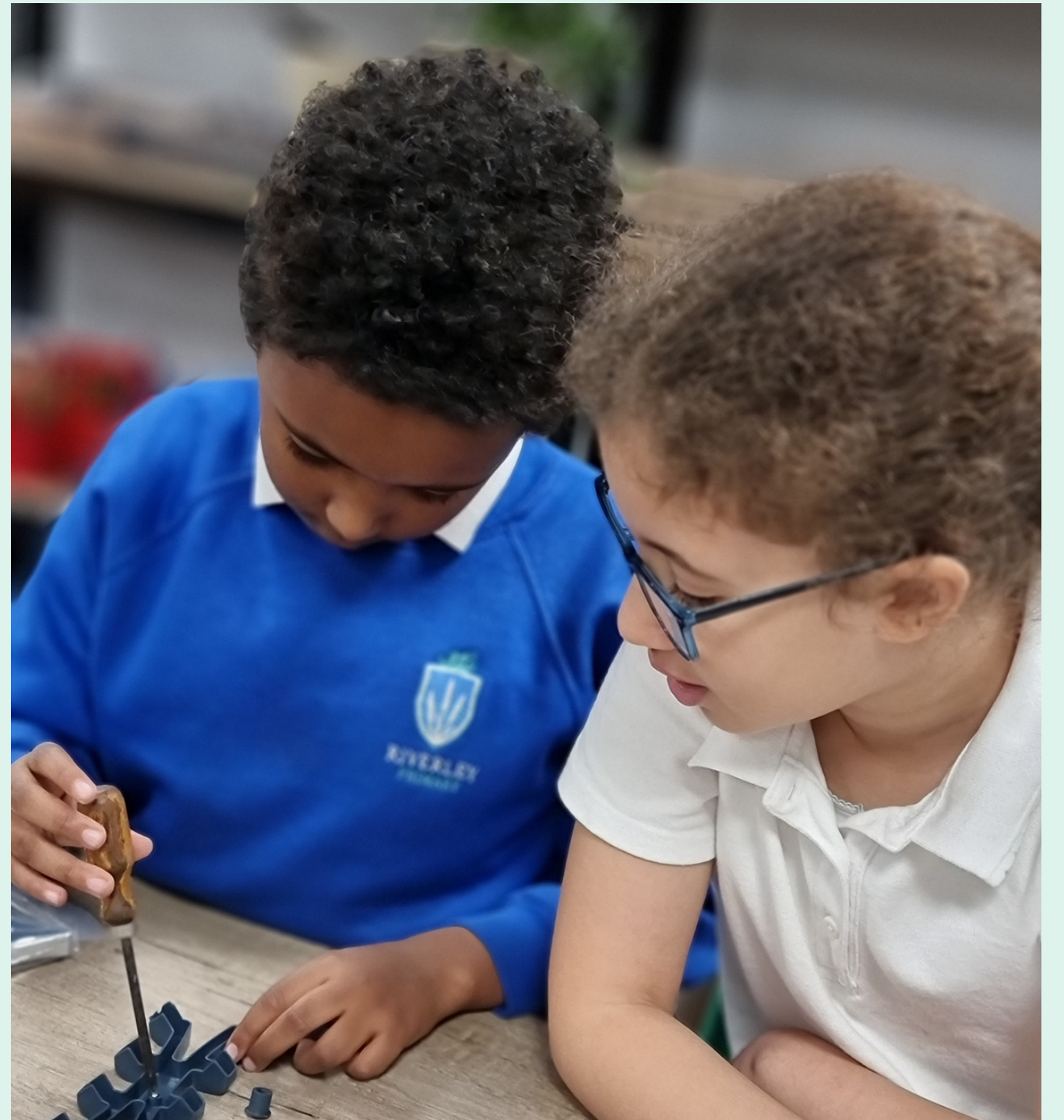
# Wide Horizons

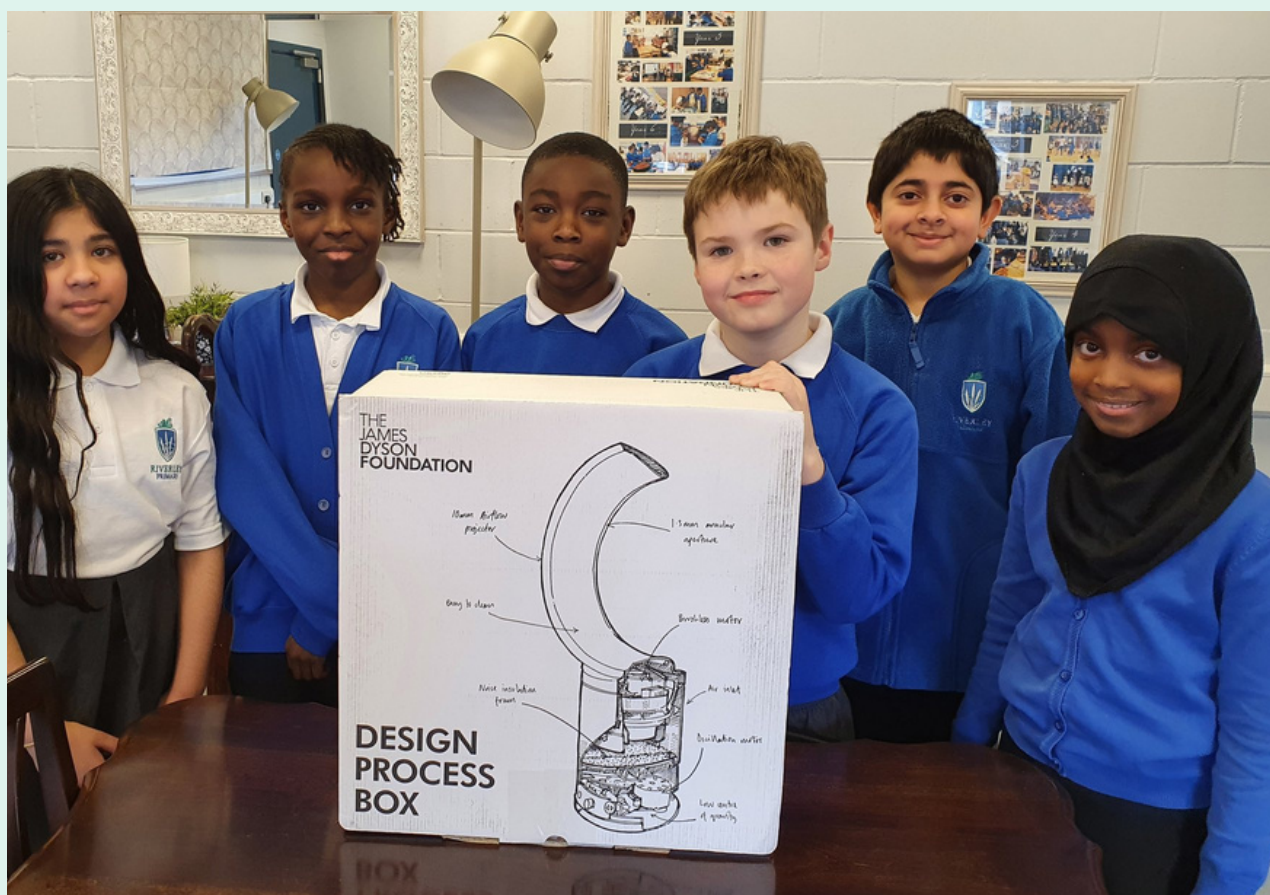
