Lost property

We are seeing increasing amounts of lost property at school and want every item to be returned to its owner. We understand the added expense that is incurred once your child loses something and how frustrating it can be

Please ensure that all items of clothing and belongings are very clearly labelled, which will allow lost items to be returned to their owner - should they be found. If labelled, items will usually be returned very quickly! Occasionally, a child may mistakenly take home an item of clothing that does not belong to them, please continue to return these to school. If you want to look in lost property, please speak to your child's class teacher.

Clubs

All children have now been provided with one free activity club. As you can imagine, it is not possible to always receive a space in your child's first preference. The admin team are now busy allocating 2nd and 3rd clubs to children – where there are spaces.

Schools Streets

Please be aware that although our roads are generally speaking 'School Streets' during drop-off and pick-up times, permit holders are permitted to drive on these roads during this time. To prioritise everyone's safety, we advise everyone to walk on the pavements.

You will see from the Key Dates that we will be dressing up on four occasions over the next two months:


